Grounds/Maintenance:

1) **Tree Removal** — Two dead white Pines west of tennis courts outside of fence are dead and must be removed. Trees will be cut at ground level, chipped/mulch with wood chips dumped near swing set/playground.

- C) Remove existing roof and Cupola and replace with new wooded cedar shakes and Cupola
- D) Rest of wood is good
