### **Discussion Items**

- 2017 Budget & Dues: Ron presented the 2017 budget which was reviewed, voted on and accepted. Dues for 2017 will be \$375 and are due by January 1, 2017. A dues email notice will be sent out this week. Mike looked into the possibility of accepting payments via the website (credit card, bank draft) but it was determined to be cost prohibitive at this point. Residents will need to mail in checks just like previous years.
- **Violations:** Letters are being emailed in the next week to 3 residents who are in violation of neighborhood covenants. They will have until 12/2 to address any issues and any resident who does not comply with the notice will be escalated to the HOA lawyer.
- Board of Director Elections: Quorum was not met so elections will be held at the December 21st meeting.
- **Facebook**: Facebook will not be used for official HOA business (this will take place via email and the website) but the board will monitor it. Lauren will take over as admin for the Harvest Farms Community page. The group will become a closed group only for current residents of Harvest Farms. Lauren will work to clean-up the page.
- Holiday Decorating Contest: Judging will occur the evening of December 19th and will be voted on by the Architectural Committee. Categories are: Best Traditional, Best Griswold and Most Decorated Street. Winning homes will have a sign placed in their yard.
